KOBRA HERITAGE 1997–2017 pays tribute to the music label and artist management Kobra Production, founded in Lausanne by Daniel Ewané. In the mid-1990s, Kobra Production was a bridge between Marseille and Lausanne, without turning its back on Paris and Geneva. At the suggestion of Simon Paccaud, CIRCUIT is hosting the launch of the KOBRA HERITAGE 1997–2017 publication at occasion of the opening of the eponymous exhibition, an assemblage that brings together several generations of artists. From hip-hop to painting, graphic design to oral history, the publication and exhibition celebrate a label that has contributed to the rap movement.

Designed by Laeticia Schwendi, the KOBRA HERITAGE 1997-2017 box set brings together the lives of activists from the Kobra era through photographic archives, press clippings and a recent collection of testimonies. This publication is a cocktail of words and thoughts bringing Kobra alive. The box set is rounded off by a musical contribution from Loop Coup. In the form of a mix tape, this audio cassette is a unique journey through his universe. Sébastian Strapazzon has done some work on the Kobra logo reminiscent of the early years of the label, launching a collection of t-shirts produced for the occasion.

Based on the work and archives of Daniel Ewané for the exhibition KOBRA HERITAGE 1997–2017, and in the spirit of the values of hip-hop, Simon Paccaud is bringing together around thirty artists from his global neighborhood. A wide range of people with whom he shares poetry, music and the motto 'Peace, Love and Unity'.
